Dear Sir,

Replying to your communication 128/1922/1 I have to inform you the Trade, as far as our Ajakuta Station is concerned for 1922 has been poor to a degree, in comparison with a normal year.

The volume is slightly in excess of last year, which was notoriously a bad one.

There seems to be an inclination, so far as I can gather, on the part of the powers that be, to divert the trade to Lokoja, why or wherefore I am unable to understand.

Rumours are rife also, that the Atta of Okeni is collecting Tax in advance, whether this be true or not I am, as yet, unable to say but if it is, the poorness of the volume of trade may be accounted for, as if the country is denuded of thousands of pounds, it is not too much to suppose that trade will suffer.
