

PART IV - GENERAL

49. The material prosperity recorded in the Report for 1950 has been maintained, and for the first time in many years there is a hope of improvement in Agricultural methods, on which alone any permanent advance in living standards must depend. There is promise also of improved communications which will end the present isolations of the Province and link it more closely to the rest of the Northern Region. Politically the year was a mixture of good and evil, but the formation of the Kwara N.A. and the reforms now under way in Igberra give hopes for the future.
